Rio de Janeiro – Curitiba – Buenos Aires – Foz do Iguaçu

Day 1

Rio de Janeiro

Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the selected hotel.

A basket of fresh fruit will be awaiting the newly wed.

Evening outing to enjoy a “bossa nova” show.

Day 2

Rio de Janeiro

Brazilian breakfast and bus ride to the “Sugar Loaf” where we will take the famous “cable car”. This rocky bulk at the entrance of Guanabara Bay is one of Rio de Janeiro landmarks which has made the city famous all over the world. This “cable car” dates from 1912 and offers one of the most dazzling panoramic views ever seen.

Lunch in a typical Steak House. Afterwards, we will visit the “Corcovado”, whose privileged location on the “Corcovado Hill” (710 meters), opposite the “Sugar Loaf” and Guanabara Bay, offers an incredible sweeping view of the city. This picturesque landscape has become a famous postcard of Rio de Janeiro.

* **Back in the city** we will stroll along Copacabana Beach, the most famous “carioca” neighbourhood. This three kilometre beach shelters the most diverse “carioca” characters.

Copacabana Fort, located at one end of the beach, ****has been since 1908, the battle scene** and spearhead of the city defense.

Arpoador Stone (“Harpooner’s Stone”), a sharp rocky point that submerges in the sea, is the most beautiful place on this beach. Its name comes from the practice of hunting whales in the times of Empire.

Ipanema Beach, with its wide sidewalks where people practise different sports, offers a unique spectacle, full of charm and “carioca” beauty.

Leblon Beach, more conservative and intimate, offers a surf show that attracts both locals and tourists.

“Rodrigo da Freitas” Lagoon is one of Rio de Janeiro most visited places, because of the practice of sports and its leisure areas.

Return to hotel.

Day 3

Rio de Janeiro – Curitiba

Brazilian breakfast and transfer to the airport to embark for Curitiba.

Arrival in Curitiba and transfer to the selected hotel. In the apartment, special bed clothes, flowers, petit fours, champagne and strawberries.

Evening free.

Day 4

Curitiba

Breakfast and transfer to the Station. A whole day tour by train (“leitorina”) will take us to the historical city of Morretes. After visiting the ****“Hills by the Sea”** we will make for “Dom Henrique” distillery, where “Magia da Serra” sugar cane brandy is made. We will also visit “Serra da Graciosa” Estate, famous for its mineral water. Lunch will consist of “Barreado”, a typical dish of the region. After lunch we will have time to visit the historical centre with its ancient large houses (where the Emperor Dom Pedro II and his court used to stay), we will pay a visit to the local artisans and to a plaster factory. We will drive back along Graciosa Highway (“Estrada da Graciosa”), considered one of the nicest in Brazil.

Arrival to the hotel about 17:30 pm.

Evening free.

Day 5

Curitiba – Buenos Aires (Argentina)

Brazilian breakfast and whole day excursion visiting Tiradentes Square, Metropolitan Cathedral, Parana University, Guaira Theatre, ***“Our Lady of the Perpetual Relief”** Church, 24 Hour Street, Botanical Gardens, Pope’s Woods, Arame Opera, Environment University, Tangua Park, Flower Clock and German Woods. Lunch will consist of Italian food at the gastronomic neighbourhood of “Santa Felicidade”.

Return to hotel and transfer to the airport to embark for Buenos Aires.

Arrival to Buenos Aires, transfer to the selected hotel and overnight.

Day 6

Buenos Aires

Continental breakfast and citytour visiting the National Congress, Civic Centre (“Plaza de Mayo”, Pink House, Metropolitan Cathedral, “Cabildo”, “Mayo Pyramid”), Colon Theatre, Cervantes Theatre, San Telmo and La Boca neighbourhoods, “Puerto Madero”, Botanical Gardens, Racecourse, Planetarium and Recoleta neighbourhood.

After dinner we will enjoy an unforgettable tango show.

Day 7

Buenos Aires.

After breakfast we will attend the “Gaicho Festival”, where we will enjoy the traditional dances and the argentinian country music.

Reception at the estate with turnovers and argentine wine. Afterwards, an incredible barbecue (“argentinian asado”). In the afternoon, traditional folk show, rodeo and horse exhibition.

Return to hotel.

Day 8

Buenos Aires – Foz do Iguaçu

Breakfast and transfer to the airport for flight to “Puerto Iguazu”.

Reception at the airport and visit to the “Iguazu Waterfalls” (argentinian side).

Hotel lodging at brazilian side.

Evening free.

Day 9

Foz do Iguaçu

Breakfast and whole day tour visiting the “Iguazu Waterfalls” (brazilian side), “Macuco Safari”, Itaipu Dam and Birds Park. Lunch at “Puerto Canoas” Restaurant.
